What is The Nostalgia Box?

The Nostalgia Box is Australia's first interactive Video Game Console Museum, located in Northbridge. A day at The Nostalgia Box promises new experiences, a loving trip down memory lane and a crash course in the history of gaming.



Museum Area

In our museum, we have over 100 consoles on display, ranging from the 70s through to the present. Going through the museum and reading the stories of each consoles, students can go behind the scenes and uncover the 'making' of the present-day consoles.



Games Area

After going through the history of the consoles in our museum, students now get the opportunity to experience the technology of the past. We have all the classics such as the Pong, Space Invaders, Super Mario Bros and many more available for playing.

Fantastic lunch break spots around the museum

We prepare materials that students can work on during their visit. Questions and answers will be provided to teachers beforehand.

GENERAL OVERVIEW

Student Capacity

We can cater large groups of up to 50 students. For larger groups, we suggest splitting the group into more manageable small groups where one can visit other locations such as the Cultural Centre while the other visit The Nostalgia Box. And do a swap over after 1 hour.

Duration

Allow at least 1 hour for the visit

Price

Supervisor/Supervisory Team

The Nostalgia Box will have at least one staff member on duty at all times to work with the students and teachers, however they will not take any role in a supervisory context. Please note that the staff member on duty will monitor behaviour and will intervene where behaviour or activities put property and/or safety of individuals and other visitors at risk.

As such, we do require a supervisory team for all excursions. The school supervisory team must accompany students throughout the excursion, actively monitoring behaviour and to intervene when necessary.

The Nostalgia Box Supervisor Ratio:

Years K to 3 – Minimum 1 adult to every 5 students Years 4 to 6 – Minimum 1 adult to every 8 students Years 7 to 12 – Minimum 1 adult to every 12 students

Payment Options

Option 1 – Payment can be made on the day via cash/credit card. A tax receipt will be provided on the day.

Option 2 – An invoice can be issued to the school 7 days after the excursion.
