Supervisor/Supervisory Team

The Nostalgia Box will have at least one staff member on duty at all times to work with the students and teachers, however they will not take any role in a supervisory context. Please note that the staff member on duty will monitor behaviour and will intervene where behaviour or activities put property and/or safety of individuals and other visitors at risk.

As such, we do require a supervisory team for excursions to The Nostalgia Box. The school supervisory team must accompany students throughout the excursion, actively monitoring behaviour and to intervene when necessary.

Payment Options

Option 1 – Payment can be made on the day via cash/credit card. A tax receipt will be provided on the day.

Option 2 – An invoice can be issued to the school 7 days after the excursion.

Staff members at The Nostalgia Box have a current Working with Children Check and card. Emergency Response Plan

In the event of an emergency it is essential that all school visitors take directions from The Nostalgia Box staff.

If evacuation is essential all visitors will be assembled at the alley between Central TAFE and St John's court, which is in front of the museum .

Teachers will need to do a roll call and must immediately notify The Nostalgia Box staff if any students are missing. It is suggested that school supervisory teams have access to a list of the name of participating students, supervisors' contact telephone numbers, student medical information and any other relevant health information.
